

Article requirements

- Article length should be from 5 to 7 pages (including the bibliographic list), A4 format, printing type Times New Roman, size 14.
- **All the page margins**(areas) -2,5 cm all round.
- **Article type:** specify type: scientific article
- **UDC index:** size 14, on the left.
- **Title of the article:** size -14, CAPITAL semi-bold letters, center alignment, no indentation.
- ▲ Name, patronymic, surname of the author (in full):: size 14, left alignment, no indentation.
- Information about the author: organization (abbreviation, no indication of the legal form), city, country, e-mail address size 14, left alignment. Do not write the word "e-mail" in the email address; do not put a dot after the email address.
- Abstract: not more than 600 characters, including spaces; on the next line after the title of the article: indentation 1cm, size 14, width alignment.
- **Key words:** not more than 10 words, on the next line after the abstract: indentation 1 cm, size 14, width alignment.
- Acknowledgments (if any): after the keywords, words of gratitude can be given to the persons or organizations that assisted in the preparation of the article, information about grants, projects, research projects in which the article was published. Indentation 1 cm, size 14, *italics*, width alignment.
- ATTENTION! The title of the article, information about the author (except for the level of education of the student), abstract, keywords and acknowledgments are also given in English BEFORE the main text of the article.
- **The main text of the article**: size 14, indentation 1 cm, width alignment, line spacing 1, automatic hyphenation.
- ▲ **Tables**: if there is more than one table, they are numbered; title above, center alignment; "Table number..." above the title, on the right. The size of the text in the tables is 12 pt. Tables should be placed only after references.
- ▲ Figures, graphs: in black and white or colour, in * .bmp, * .jpq, * .qif, * .tiff. formats, editable. Size of the text 12, size of the title 14. Title below, center alignment. All figures and graphs should be placed only after references. If a figure or graph is only one, it is not numbered.
- ▲ Formulas are typed using Microsoft Equation 3.0 / MathType 6.0 Equation (Insert→ Text→Object→Microsoft Equation 3.0 / MathType 6.0 Equation), built-in formula editor is not allowed. Formulas should be editable and numbered in Arabic numerals in round brackets at the end of the line.
- **A References**: in square brackets in the order they are mentioned.



The heading **bibliographic list** should be placed one line from the text of the article, in the center, size - 14. The list of references is numbered in the order references are mentioned in the text, it should be made out in accordance with the National Standard for Bibliographic Description — GOST R 7.0.5–2008, indentation - 1cm, width alignment. Bibliographic references to the list of references should be made out with an indication on a line of text in square brackets of a digital serial number. The article should contain no more than 10 sources.

Attention!

- All materials will be checked for the amount of borrowing in the Antiplagiat system (https://antiplagiat.ru). The originality of the text should be at least 70%, taking into account the volume of citation (at the same time, the volume of originality itself cannot be less than 50%). Otherwise, the organizers reserve the right to reject the article or return it for revision.
- A The authors of the articles can be scientists and students only at the bachelor's, master's and postgraduate levels.
- Authors should make at least one reference to the articles of employees of USFEU published in the journal "Forests of Russia and Economy in them" (not considering self-citations), as well as in other journals published in scientometric databases (RSCI, Web of Science, Scopus, etc.)"
